Transcript

AN ACT

To provide for the forestation and reforestation of lands in the state of Oregon; to provide for the classification of said lands; to provide for the administration of the act; to provide for the annual forest fee and yield tax on such lands and their forest crops; to provide penalties for its violations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

Section 1. The purposes of this act are:

- (1) To encourage the growth and protection of forest crops on lands chiefly valuable therefor.
