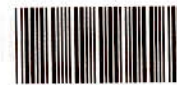

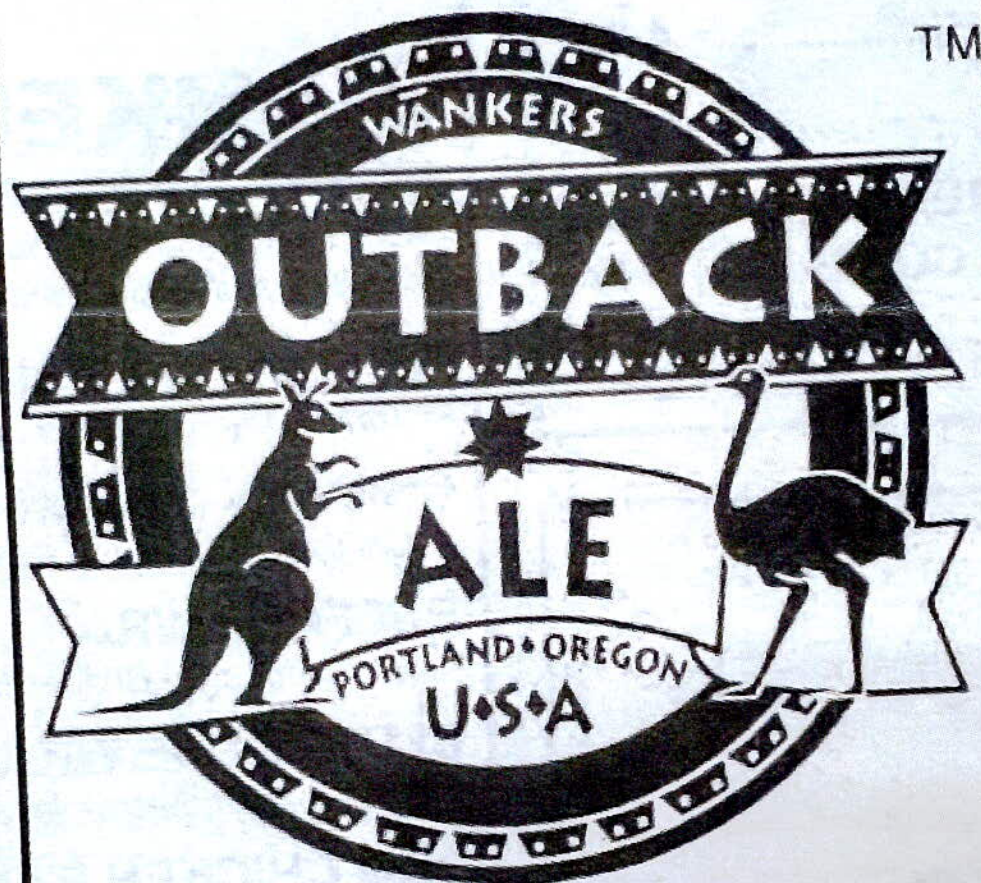

The charge, in place only on dance nights, is a hit with the patrons, and the money raised for the Oregon Food Bank has grown along with the popularity of the saloon, where lines of people can be seen on Friday and Saturday nights, waiting for a table.

Why the Oregon Food Bank? We were looking for a charitable organization to help, and we know that the food bank is legitimate. With approximately 600 agencies in its network, it is able to send the donations directly to the local area.

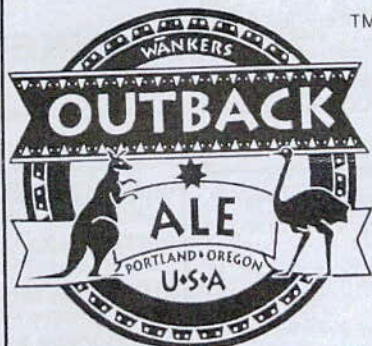
