The following notes on Diagnosis of Mental Diseases and regulations were tentatively adopted:

Mental defectives not only include the great class of feeble-minded but some delinquents and incorrigibles. Mental defectives constitute one per cent of the pupils enrolled in the elementary grades and are found in two percent of all families. Available figures serve to show that the number of mental defectives is increasing at a rapid rate. Feeble-mindedness is classified as accidental or hereditary. It is plain that heredity is the chief cause of a large group of mental defectives. The children of two feeble-minded parents are almost without exception defective. Defectives beget defectives. Feeble-mindedness is a serious and in most cases a permanent arrest of brain development causing defective intelligence which dates from birth or early life. Feeble-minded persons rarely acquire sufficient judgment and competency to lead an independent existence in society. They need guidance, supervision and in many cases support.

A "feeble-minded" person is one who is capable of carning a living but from birth is unable to compete mentally with his normal fellows, and who has diminished ability to care for himself and his affairs. An "imbecile" is one who is defective from birth and is incapable of carning his own living but may guard against physical dangers.

An "idiot" is a person who is absolutely defective from birth and is not even able to guard himself against physical danger. The less defective feeble—minded are termed "morons". Each class is divided into three grades, high, middle and low. The majority of mental defectives are congenital, although the cause of such condition may occur at or after birth.

While feeble-mindedness in its various forms is frequently due to heredity it is not always due to that cuase. Conditions that predispose to the birth of mentally defective children are feeble-mindedness in parents, syphilis, tuberculosis, cancer and alcoholism.

Feeble-mindedness is undoubtedly increasing and it is only a question of time when civilization will wake up to the impossibility of properly caring for these unfortunates. Reports serve to show that feeble-mindedness is increasing at twice the rate of the general population. There is sufficient evidence to show that feeble-mindedness produces more pauperism, degeneracy and crime than any other source. A careful study will show that the mating of unfit individuals is producing a swarm of unfit descendants.

The most difficult mental defective to control is the moron. They usually produce large families of indigent and delinquent children. The high grade defective is the most troublesome, partly because he has sufficient mentality to go about by himself and get into all kinds of mischief, either on his own account or led on by someone else. The male morons grow into paupers, drinkers, hoboes and ne'er do wells and fill out hospitals and asylums. The female morons grow up into irresponsible women.

The diagnosis of feeble-mindedness can usually be made in the older children but it may be very difficult in the very young. The recognition of the lower grade of mental deficiency is easy but the moron grades often present great diagnostic difficulties. Every case demands a thorough study even though the diagnosis is quite obvious. Any physical basis for the mental deficiency should be corrected. All cases should be carefully tested psychometrically. Psychological tests are instruments of precision and should be applied only by those who have a thorough training and experience in their work. The child's school record frequently determines the necessity for a psychological test.

The family history and environment should be given in full. The personal history from birth is of great importance. The physical examination should be as complete as possible. The diagnosis of feeble-mindedness is often difficult. In the higher grades it cannot be made on the psychological test alone. Two years of retardation in children nine or under, and three years or over, is always serious. Great care should be exercised in differentiating the mentally retarded cases from the feeble-minded.

When a case has been found to be mentally defective there are four methods for preventing the propagation of defectives (1) education, (2) isolation, (3) segregation, (4) surgery. Education directed toward the defective is a failure for he is incapable of profiting by the lesson and lacks self control.

Restrictive legislation is praiseworthy but has failed as a preventive measure and merely adds illegitimacy to degeneracy. Segregation would be an ideal method of isolating those who are incapable of having normal offspring but the isolation of all degenerates and defectives would be an expensive and impractical procedure. Hospitals for the insame, homes for epileptics, institutions for feeble-minded, reformatory schools cannot be regarded as preventative measures. Defectives propagate their kind before and sometimes after they are entered in such institutions. Segregation of the higher type of mental defective is not likely to be accomplished nor is it practical.

Sterlization is an effective means of preventing the propagation of feeble-minded. This is done by severing the vas deferens in the male or the fallopian tubes in the female. In vasectomy the distal end of the duct is tied and the operation is very simple and can be performed in three minutes. There is no diminuation of the sexual forces or pleasures. In the female both tubes are ligated near the uterus and severed beyond the ligature.

Practically all the patients sterilized are satisfied with the operation and the results. In spite of their limited intelligence they seem to realize the undersirability of further childbearing.

Before presenting cases for the action of the Oregon State Board of Eugenics, a written history of the innate traits, mental and physical condition and family history should include the following information:

I. A complete family history of both parents and other direct relatives should state definitely in regard to mental defectiveness, epilepsy, convulsive diseases, neurosis and psychopathics.

II. The age, occupation, environment, blood relationship of parents and the presence of tuberculosis, syphilis or other chronic diseases should be noted.

III. A history of the case from birth in regard to the development, environment, illnesses and innate traits should be recorded.

IV. A complete physical examination should be made for defects that can be corrected and these defects corrected before presentation to the Board.

V. The weight, standing height, sitting height, cranial measurements, lung capacity, right and left grip should be included in the report.

VI. All cases should be tested psychometrically and standard tests repeated at intervals of six months and more frequently if necessary, for a period of not less than two years.

VII. At least one of these tests should be made by a psychiatrist with medical training.

VIII. The school history, the general intelligence, knowledge, judgment and the ability of the individual to care for himself should also be included in the report.

IX. Due consideration in the examination should be given to racial and language differences.

S. If there are no immediate relatives or if the parents are not of sufficient intelligence to give consent, a guardian should be appointed by the court making the commitment. Failure to appoint a guardian shall be considered sufficient to refuse action.

XI. An accurate record of the case shall be forwarded to the members of the Board at least one week previous to the date of the regular meeting.
