Series includes ledgers containing the date, source, and price of book and document accessions as well as statistics on the number and cost of books, newspapers, and documents that were bound or rebound.

Correspondence documents communications of the state library with the American Library Association (ALA). Subjects include library services to army camps and soldiers during World War I, the exchange of information about libraries in Oregon and the services they provide, loyalty oaths, and intellectual freedom. Eleanor Stephens, state librarian, 1941-1958, was active in ALA and its committees and much of the correspondence documents her involvement with the organization and with the affiliated National Association of State Librarians.

Series documents the routine communications and activities of the Archives Division from its establishment in 1945 until 1973 when it was transferred to the Office of the Secretary of State. Subjects include the establishment of the Records Center, the Records Management Program, a microfilming program for state agencies, and the budget.

Series documents the activities of the Archives Division and the development of the state's archival program. Series includes correspondence, reports, and committee minutes. Subjects include establishing the archives, the appointment of David C. Duniway as State Archivist in 1945, the protection of archival material during wartime, and reports of the Archival Subcommittee of the Committee on Conservation of Cultural Resources which was part of the World War II History Project.

Series contains printed lists of books recommended by the State Library to libraries, schools, and organizations throughout the state. Lists were generally compiled by age group or by topic such as drama, fiction, poetry, history, biography, gardening, health, rural life, and city planning.

Transactions include purchases for the traveling and school libraries, state archives, archives microfilming services, printing, and books.

"Letters to Libraries" were circular letters sent to public libraries, Oregon State Library Trustees, and university and college librarians in Oregon. The newsletters, which were called "Special Bulletins" from 1955 to 1958, communicated news of library events, history, programs, services, and employees.

Often included with the circular letters were special mailings of brochures, pamphlets, library publications, bookmarks, bibliographies and book lists, library directories, and KOAC Radio Program Guides. In June 1955 the mailing included booklets about the history and the 50th anniversary of publications of the State Library.

Newsletters for 1928, 1929, and 1942-1954 are missing.

Significant correspondence takes place with other state agencies, the Oregon State Library Board of Trustees, presidents and librarians of Oregon universities and colleges, members of the state legislative assembly, and librarians in other states.

Topics discussed include the conversion of the card catalog to an automated book catalog system in the 1960s, bookmobiles, the library building, librarians, library schools and library programs, rural library services and field visits to rural areas, the history of the state library including the 50th anniversary in 1955, the Oregon Historical Society, the Pacific Northwest Bibliographic Center, and detention centers for Americans of Japanese descent during World War II.

Photographs of the state librarians, library exhibits, posters, and bookmobiles; architectural drawings, blueprints, and photographs of the library building in Salem; and audio tapes have been removed to separate locations.

There is extensive correspondence with the librarians of the Portland Library Association which operated the local public libraries in Portland. Mary Francis Isom, head librarian of the Portland Library Association, 1905-1916, was a frequent correspondent. The section on Portland also contains correspondence with companies and organizations headquartered in Portland.

The statistics include population, number of volumes, circulation, receipts, and expenditures. The reports for 1939-1942 are misssing.

Arranged in folders and scrapbooks, the publications include circular letters, postals, and memos; book and magazine lists; biennial reports; posters, pamphlets, fliers, sample letterhead and forms, bookmarks; and information about professional meetings and bulletins of the Pacific Northwest Library Association.

The publications were sent to librarians, grange lecturers, Oregon State Library Trustees, county school superintendents, county agricultural agents, legislators, and borrowers of traveling, school, and children's libraries.

Radio Program Records 1928-1954 .4 cubic feet Arrangement: Chronological by year.

Series contains correspondence, program schedules, and scripts that document library radio programs. Some of the radio programs were part of weekly broadcast programs called "Ask Your State Library," 1942-1943, and "Library Hour," 1949. The programs answered questions about books and library services, recommended books, interviewed visiting librarians, and discussed topics of interest such as the World War II "Victory Book Campaign" and war journalists.

The bulk of the radio scripts date from 1942-1954.

The loan and accession records and book lists document the activities of the traveling library department which circulated books to clubs, organizations, teachers, schools, or other residents of Oregon rural areas that had no access to a county or city library. Books were lent in groups of twenty to fifty and shipped by mail or freight company for periods of up to six months.

The printed lists conveyed information on books available for circulation and included the names of books along with author, title, and other bibliographic information. Traveling libraries contained a selection of fifty books and little libraries contained twenty to twenty-five books for adults and children. Children's libraries contained books for school children.

Volumes 1-5 contain lists of books in traveling, little, and children's libraries and other lists by topic or age group. Volumes 6-7 (1905-1912) contain loan records; volumes 8-10 (1905-1943) contain accession and withdrawal records; volume 11 (1944-1959) contains volume, station, and loan records.

Volume 11 has been removed to a separate location.

Victory Book Campaign Records 1941-1946 1.1 cubic feet, photographs Arrangement: Chronological by year.

Series documents the activities of the Victory Book Campaign in Oregon during World War II. The Victory Book Campaign was a program to gather donated books and distribute them to men and women serving in the armed forces.

The correspondence section of this series includes letters, memorandum, manuals, press releases, newsletters, and circulars from the national organization. The series also contains publicity brochures, fliers, posters, radio spots, and radio transcripts; photographs of sorting, repairing, packing, and displaying books; and financial and statistical reports. The State Librarian, Eleanor Stephens, was the state director of the campaign in Oregon.
