Hart InterCivic 6.2.1
Windows 7 Upgrade

Hart InterCivic has upgraded the operating system on Hart Voting System version 6.2.1 from Windows 2000 to Windows 7. They have also added driver software for a new Canon scanner. They have requested administrative approval of this change in operating system for use in Oregon elections.

After thorough vendor testing, the office of the Secretary of State partnered with Benton County, Washington, and the Washington Secretary of State's Office on July 3, 2012 for a complete test of the system on Windows 7. We have determined that the upgraded system complies with the statutory requirements of Oregon Revised Statutes 246.550 and 246.560, specifically ORS 246.550(4) in that this change in operating system does not impair the accuracy, efficiency, or capacity of the machine or system.

Accordingly, the Hart Voting System 6.2.1 with the Windows 7 operating system is certified for use in all elections in Oregon. The system must be used in compliance with the provisions of applicable Oregon statutes and all Secretary of State, Election's Division rules and directives.
