SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits sale of malt beverages and nonalcoholic beverages in non-returnable containers. Provides penalty. Authorizes Department of Agriculture to revoke or suspend license of violator.
