JOINT INTERIM MODEL COMMITTEE RULES

BALLOT MEASURES

Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly

The Joint Interim Committee on Ballot Measure 87 will operate in accordance with the Oregon Constitution, Senate and House Rules, Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure, and applicable statutory provisions.

- 1. Joint Interim Committee rules may be amended by affirmative vote of the majority of the Joint Interim Committee, but at least one day's notice shall be given in writing to each Joint Interim Committee member.
- 2. A quorum shall be comprised of a majority of the members of each house appointed to the Joint Interim Committee.
- 3. The committee members shall call Joint Interim Committee meetings, set agendas and cause notice of the time and place of meetings.
- 4. Hearing notices identifying an agenda of subjects to be considered by the Joint Interim Committee shall be posted in accordance with Senate and House Rules.
- 5. All meetings of the Joint Interim Committee shall be open to the public.
- 6. Upon the request of one member, a roll call vote shall be taken and recorded on any question.
- 7. A majority of the appointed members of each house shall be required to approve recommendations.
