

## **Oregon Elder Abuse Work Group (HB 2205)**

### **Proposed Rules**

Meetings will operate in accordance with the Oregon Constitution, applicable statutory provisions and general parliamentary law.

1. A majority of the appointed members of the Oregon Elder Abuse Work group shall elect two members to serve as Co-Chairs.
2. Rules may be amended by affirmative vote of the majority of members, but at least one day's notice shall be given in writing to each work group member.
3. No seconds are required to a motion.
4. A quorum shall be comprised of a majority of the appointed members. In the absence of a quorum, the Co-Chair may assign fewer members to receive public testimony.
5. The Co-Chair shall call meetings, set agendas and cause notice of the time and place of meetings.
6. All meetings are open and shall comply with public meetings law.
7. Upon request of one member, a roll call vote shall be taken and recorded on any question placed before the work group.
8. A majority of the appointed members shall be required to approve recommendations.
