019 Ken Malmin Dean, Portland Bible College. Submits and reads prepared testimony in support of SB 1039 with the -4 amendments **(EXHIBIT B)**. Comments on the schools affected by the exemption. Refers to page two and reads about the current situation.

089 Greg Chaimov Attorney, representing the Portland Bible College. Explains the criteria for exemption and the appeal process for a dispute between the school and the office.

112 Rep. March Inquires about section nine in the -4 amendments and asks about the cap for fees.

123 Chaimov Responds the cap will still be set by administrative rules.

128 Chair Flores Refers to the memorandum from Alan Contreras in support of the SB 1039 with the -4 amendments **(EXHIBIT C)**.
