024	Rep. Nolan	States support for the bill in its current form and passing the bill directly to the House floor.
027	Rep. Lim	Asks if Rep. Nolan will vote to pass the bill from committee.
030	Rep. Nolan	Answers yes, but notes that the legislative session will soon be completed and expresses concern that the future of the bill could be in jeopardy.
033	Rep. Lim	States support for passing the bill to the House Committee on State and Federal Affairs with recommendation, but will support the motion to pass the bill without recommendation.
