003 Chair Berger Calls the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m. and opens a public hearing on SB 90A.

SB 90A – PUBLIC HEARING

005 Cara Fischer Committee Administrator. Summarizes SB 90A.

022 Chair Berger Comments that she was appointed to the Capitol Planning Commission before it was abolished.

030 Bill Foster Administrator of the Facilities Division, Department of Administrative Services. Submits prepared testimony explaining SB 90A (**EXHIBIT A**). Talks about what SB 90A would do.

050 Foster Comments on the amendments that were made in the Senate.

059 Chair Berger Inquires if the Capitol Projects Advisory Board includes all projects statewide.

067 Foster Concurs.

075 Chair Berger Questions if representatives from the City of Salem will consider all issues brought before the Capitol Projects Advisory Board, or just those pertaining to decisions inside Salem city limits.

077 Foster Answers that the representatives from the City of Salem are permanent members of the board.

084 Chair Berger Asks how often the board meets, and how the board handles public notice and public input.

085 Foster Responds that the board meets monthly, depending on the amount of work. Talks about the process and public notification.

099 Rep. Cameron Asks how many employees are currently supporting the commission.

102 Foster Answers that there were two part-time employees but when the suspension occurred they were let go.

109 Chair Berger Closes the public hearing on SB 90A and opens a work session on SB 90A.

190 Chair Berger Inquires if, by statute, they are required to file the information and this information changes the statute so they no longer have to file the information.

192 Rep. Sumner Comments on Global Position Satellites (GPS). Asks if GPS is as accurate as the old system.
