## TAPE 84, A

003 Chair Jenson Calls the meeting to order at 2:15 p.m. Announces that SB 56 A, SB 696, SB 896 A will be held over until Wednesday, May 11, 2005. Stands at ease at 2:17 p.m. Reconvenes at 2:20 p.m. Opens a public hearing on HB 3472.

### HB 3472 – PUBLIC HEARING

020 Rep. Wayne Krieger House District 1. Provides background on HB 3472 and testifies in support of the bill.

046 Rep. Dingfelder Inquires about the fees for Oregon boats in California and Washington.

053 Rep. Krieger Addresses equity among states.

060 Chair Jenson Wonders whether Oregon fishermen could be jeopardized from going to California and Washington due to Oregon's fees.

063 Rep. Krieger Responds negatively.

067 Rep. Krummel Notes Section 2, which addresses dates of permits for certain species. Questions why bill refers to past dates.

077 Rep. Krieger Explains why HB 3472 will apply to certain past license applications.

088 Rep. Brown Inquires if most fisheries are limited entry. Questions if many commercial licenses will be sold to non-residents.

095 Krieger States that commercial fisherman who already have permits in Oregon will want to get licenses.

116 Roy Elicker Deputy Director, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW). Submits written testimony (**EXHIBIT A**) and testifies in support of HB 3472. Provides background on the bill.

128 Rep. Brown Inquires if non-residents need the license if they land fish or only if they are within the three-mile limit.

- 135 Patty Burke Marine Program Leader, Newport. Explains that non-residents will need a license if they are fishing in Oregon. Mentions the fish that will likely necessitate the license.
- 140 Joseph Rohleder Oregon Aquaculture Association (OAA). Testifies in support of HB 3472. States that HB 3472 is in line with OAA's intent.
- 154 Rep. Krummel Inquires whether the unsustainability of fisheries led to the sunset provision on new vessel permits.
- 159 Rohleder Explains why fisheries requested limited entries, and relates the difficulties drafting language for limited entries.
- 187 Chair Jenson Closes public hearing and opens a work session on HB 3472.

- 191 Sandy Thiele-Cirka Administrator. Mentions subsequent referral to the House committee on Budget.
- 193 Rep. Dingfelder **MOTION: Moves HB 3472 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation and BE REFERRED to the committee on Budget by prior reference.**
- VOTE: 7-0-0**
- AYE: In a roll call vote, all members present vote Aye.**
- 203 Chair Jenson **The motion CARRIES.**
- 205 Chair Jenson Closes work session on HB 3472. Opens a work session on SJM 7.

### **SJM 7 – WORK SESSION**

- 209 Sandy Thiele-Cirka Administrator. Reviews testimony and background on SJM 7.
- 225 Rep. Barnhart **MOTION: Moves SJM 7 be sent to the floor with a BE ADOPTED recommendation.**
- 234 Rep. Krummel Comments that he hopes SJM 7 will encourage Congress to move.

258 Chair Jenson Closes work session on SJM 7. Opens a work session on SB 410.

274 Chair Jenson Inquires if the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) is enthusiastically supportive of SB 410.

282 Roy Elicker Deputy Director, ODFW. Expresses enthusiastic support for SB 410.

289 Rep. Tomei **MOTION: Moves SB 410 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation.**

**VOTE: 7-0-0**

**AYE: In a roll call vote, all members present vote Aye.**

297 Chair Jenson The motion CARRIES.

299 Rep. Dingfelder **MOTION: Moves SB 410 be placed on the CONSENT CALENDAR.**

**VOTE: 7-0-0**

**304 Chair Jenson Hearing no objection, declares the motion CARRIED.**

307 Chair Jenson Closes work session on SB 410. Adjourns the meeting at 2:38 p.m.
