007	Bill Taylor	Counsel. Indicates HB 2306B makes unmarried parents of minor child liable for expenses and education of child. Introduces B8 amendments which removes the creation of a Task Force on Children's Access to Health Care ( <b>EXHIBIT A</b> ). Notes the fiscal impact for the task force is approximately \$26,000 ( <b>EXHIBIT B</b> ).
016	Chair Krieger	Comments that Rep. Nolan sent a letter to the Speaker requesting that this issue be worked on during the interim.
<b>020</b>	<b>Sen. Beyer</b>	<b>MOTION: Moves to ADOPT HB 2306B-8 amendments dated 07/13/05.</b>
023	Sen. Monnes Anderson	Thanks everyone for their work on this issue and is glad Rep. Nolan has agreed to work on this during the interim.
