031	Dave Barrows	Testifies if favor of memorial. Association of O&C Counties is the primary requester of the memorial. It will sunset in September 2006. Urges committee to continue this program.
054	Gil Riddell	Testifies in favor of HJM 1-A. Oregon receives over one half billion dollars from this legislation. Hopes bill will lead to sustainable forest practices and boost Oregon's economy.
068	Barrows	Rural counties and schools will suffer immensely if this program is not renewed.
092	Riddell	Concurs. Notes, this program is already in place. Oregon gets 54% of the money that is paid nationally.

223	Harvey Rogers	Testifies in favor of SB 23. Amendments are technical corrections that deal with word changes. The word "borrowing" replaces "obligation". New section 33 at the end replaces proposed language contained in SB 28.
265	Rogers	Notes change to Property Taxing Authority associated with general obligation bonds. Timing issue. Tax is dedicated by constitution, can only be used to pay general obligation bonds.
