SB 5584 – Oregon Student Assistance Commission		
005	Steve Bender	Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO). Submits memo from May 23, 2005 (EXHIBIT 1), memo from July 5, 2005 (EXHIBIT 2), and Opportunity Grant Budget Comparisons (EXHIBIT 3). Discusses July 5, 2005 memo and the Oregon Student Assistance funds.
041	Bender	Asks committee to increase funds, upon receiving information regarding the federal funding of the program. Comments on package in Governor's budget that adds funds to expand opportunity grants.
058	Bender	Recommends reducing funds in package 200 from level in Governor's budget to allow general fund expansions in opportunity grant program.
068	Chair Devlin	Notes a typo on the chart.
070	Bender	Corrects chart: House and Senate Budget numbers should be reversed in the bottom three rows. Describes chart (EXHIBIT 3).
114	Bender	Recommends that the committee approve the Budget note. Comments on prioritization if there is a budget shortfall.
129	Chair Devlin	Explains that a budget shortfall is not anticipated. Relates intent to get everything running by the second year. States that he would accept a motion to approve the LFO recommendations.
140	Sen. Gordly	Moves to approve the LFO recommendations.
142	Sen. Walker	Inquires if more numbers were switched on the chart (EXHIBIT 3).
145	Bender	Responds negatively; clarifies the correction.
146	Sen. Nelson	Inquires where money is coming from to fund commission.
150	Chair Devlin	Explains adjustments to allow funding for commission.
155	Sen. Gordly	Inquires if there are Budget notes in the House version of the budget.
157	Bender	Responds affirmatively, and points out memo (EXHIBIT 1) noting the House Budget notes. Explains.
185	Sen. Gordly	Inquires about range of awards.
188	Bender	Explains existing methodology to grant awards.
212	Sen. Whitsett	Inquires about maximum increases allowed in tuition.

269	Chair Devlin	Comments on Capitol Construction issues. States that there is nothing left to schedule for the subcommittee.
280	Sen. Gordly	Questions what the process is that will result in other policy bills coming to subcommittee or not. Inquires about criteria being used to select bills.
291	Chair Devlin	Explains how bills will come to subcommittee, and comments on short-list. States that there are not many bills that could possibly come to subcommittee.
311	Chair Devlin	Adjourns the meeting at 1:25 p.m.
