007	Chair Gordly	Opens a Possible reconsideration and Work Session on SB 5583 – District Attorneys and Their Deputies. (Exhibit #1, Senate Bill 5583). The Chair asks for a unanimous consent that the rules be suspended to allow a motion to reconsider the vote by which SB 5583 was reported out with a recommendation to the full committee. Asks if there are any objections.
013	Sen. Devlin	Responds no.
014	Chair Gordly	Vote: 2 – 0 – 1 Ayes: Senators Devlin, Chair Gordly Exc.: Senator Winters Hearing no objections, declares the motion CARRIED.
015	Chair Gordly	Agrees to accept a motion.
	Sen. Devlin	MOVES to reconsider the vote by which they passed out SB 5583 to the Full Committee.
020	Chair Gordly	Vote: 2 – 0 – 1 Ayes: Senators Devlin, Chair Gordly Exc.: Senator Winters Hearing no objections, declares the motion CARRIED.
022	Chair Gordly	Asks the record to show that when the committee last meet on SB 5583 there was an outstanding issue that they wanted noted for the record which is captured on the top of page 2 in Exhibit #2, Memorandum from Doug Wilson. Notes where they last left their discussion.
038	Doug Wilson, Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO)	Explains the only difference between what they passed out previously and what is in front of them today is Package 101. (Exhibit #3, Work Session Action Report). Also mentions that there is still the elimination of the amount paid to counties to supplement the salaries of the deputy district attorneys.
