112	Mazen Malik	Provided background on HB 2489, (Exhibit 3), has no fiscal or revenue impact.
125	Chair Shetterly	Clarified, there are proposed amendments that are conceptual at present.
130	Charles Stern	Testified in favor of HB 2489, (Exhibit 4).
190		Questions and discussion interspersed on general and limited powers of attorney.
227	Barnhart	Under this rule, a corporation would always have to appear through a licensed practitioner?
230	Stern	Affirmative, unless someone is designated at the corporate level to engage in tax activities; generally it is someone who is licensed.
241	Chair Shetterly	That's beyond the scope of this bill?
243	Stern	Answered affirmatively.
245	Chair Shetterly	Suggested that the amendments should be discussed with Dave Hendricks in Judiciary, so it corresponds with the power of attorney statute.
257	Chair Shetterly	Closed the Public Hearing on HB 2489
270	Chair Shetterly	Meeting adjourned at 8:55 a.m.
