008	Mark Ellsworth	Informs the committee about the HB 2020B-27 amendments, <b>(EXHIBIT A)</b> .
015	Dave Heynderickx	Senior Deputy Legislative Counsel. Reviews the significant changes on page 2, lines 8 – 11; page 3, line 28; and page 4, line 11.
048	Sen. Minnis	Asks does this apply to “equal to or better than”.
050	Heynderickx	Answers that the “equal to or better than” has remained untouched in these amendments.
		Continues to review significant changes, line 22.
074	Heynderickx	Continues to review, page 5, Section 44b; and Section 44c.
098	Heynderickx	Continues to review, Section 44d, the statement of legislative intent, and Section 44e regarding start up costs.
106	Heynderickx	Continues to review, page 7, line 25 fiscal impact statement requirement for all bills that increase employer contributions; page 8, line 13 provides three plan options for people who are elected or appointed to the legislative assembly.
146	Heynderickx	Section 46b, page 9 is the provision for existing members of the legislative assembly. Section 46c provides for the Oregon Growth Plan changes.
191	Heynderickx	Continues to review, page 12, 46c provides that legislators who are appointed or elected from here on out will go the 1.67% instead of the 2%.
190	Heynderickx	Concludes with the final change on the last page.
