008	Judith Callens	Committee Administrator. Explains that SB 820-D14 amendments (EXHIBIT A) completely replaces Section 7 and resolves a conflict HB 2268 by updating the fee schedule.
020	Rep. Jenson	Asks if there is any reason why this bill would need to go to the committee on Ways and Means.
025	Callens	Answers this bill will go directly to the floor to be re-passed.
027	Rep. Jenson	Asks if the bill passes out of committee without this amendment and passed in the D engrossed form, and since HB 2268 already passed both chambers, the fee of \$100 would be re-enacted.
034	Callens	Answers affirmatively, whichever bill passes last is the bill that dictates.
060	Chair Ferrioli	Opens the work session on SB 820D.
