004 Chair Deckert Calls meeting to order at 1:09pm.

OPENS WORK SESSION ON SB 819

013 Steve Meyer Explains SB 819-1, -2 (Exhibit 1), -3 (Exhibit 5). Discusses changes in revenue impact from -2 amendments (Exhibits 3-4) and -3 amendments (Exhibit 6).

039 Rep. Krummel Introduces SB 819-4 amendments (Exhibit 7), which creates a grant in the formula for high growth school districts.

060 Sen. Charles Starr Testifies in support of SB 819-4 amendments because they would benefit Sherwood school district, which has experienced decreased funding and a growing population.

Discussion follows.

103 Sen. Ringo Asks about the amount of the grant.

116 Rep. Krummel Responds that the Sherwood school district has seen a reduction in funding of \$1.8 million since equalization in 1993 taking growth into account and that the \$2 million grant would bring them up to par on a per student spending level in other districts.

133 Sen. Ringo Asks about any unintended affects.

136 Rep. Krummel Responds that they are not trying preclude other high growth districts.

156 Sen. Deckert States that he will bring SB 819 back for a work session.
