003	Chair Clarno	Calls the meeting to order at 8:33 a.m. Opens a work session for measure introduction.
<u>WORK SESSION</u>		
007	Sen. Atkinson	MOTION: Moves that LC 13 and LC 36 BE INTRODUCED as committee bills. VOTE: 3-0
009	Chair Clarno	Hearing no objection, declares the motion CARRIED.
011	Admin. Marjorie Taylor	Indicates that LC 13 will be SB 1023 which reduces the amount transferred from the state fund for certain grants and LC 36 will be SB 5583 relating to state finance (EXHIBITS A & B).
018	Chair Clarno	Closes the work session on measure introduction and opens a public hearing on SR 4.
<u>SR 4 PUBLIC HEARING</u>		
031	Chair Clarno	Commends Sen. Yih for all her hard work on SR 4 which urges Economic & Community Development Department to provide certain information and reports to Legislative Assembly and public within three months.
036	Sen. Yih	Submits testimony in support of SR 4 (EXHIBIT C). Calls the committee's attention to the chart on the last page of the Final Report to Senate President Gene Derfler (EXHIBIT D). Explains the graph on expenditures for the Oregon Economic & Community Development Department (OECD). Notes that the lack of performance and lack of accountability are just two of the reasons that prompted this legislation.
