<b><u>SB 384A WORK SESSION</u></b>		
005	Chair Williams	Explains that issues were raised regarding SB 384A which eliminates certain responsibilities of State Commission on Children and Families and transfers responsibilities to Juvenile Crime Prevention Advisory Committee and Oregon Youth Authority. Indicates that a possible veto letter from the Governor would be forthcoming if the amendment regarding youths in the back of pickup trucks is put forth with the bill.
019	Chair Williams	Recesses the committee until a determination can be made about the pickup truck amendments.
022	Chair Williams	Reconvenes the committee saying that SB 384A is passing out of the committee as previously recommended on 7/3 with the A24 amendments ( <b>EXHIBIT A</b> ).
026	Chair Williams	Adjourns the meeting at 3:05 p.m.
