<u>HB 2914 – PUBLIC HEARING</u>		
006	John Leon	Committee Administrator. Reads brief synopsis of HB 2914, which allows widow or widower of veteran to keep special veteran's registration plates. Talks about the use of the word "retain". Submits –1 Amendment (EXHIBIT A) and explains that this amendment would allow the option of the surviving spouse to continue to use the registration plate on a vehicle or to keep as a memento. Also states that it establishes the same provision for prisoners of war.
010	Chair Starr	Closes public hearing on HB 2914 and opens work session on HB 2914.
