<u>HB 3395B WORK SESSION</u>		
004	Janet Adkins	Committee Administrator. Explains HB 3395 B-5 amendments (EXHIBIT A) . Explains the waivers of the Department of Education has granted for statutory timelines, student in existing school and 20% cap on enrollment out of district.
042	Sen. Fisher	Comments on the waivers.
046	Adkins	Responds that this was a joint discussion.
048	Sen. Fisher	Asks Randy Harnish how many waivers were not granted.
051	Randy Harnish	Oregon Department of Education. Responds that these were joint waivers that the State Board looked favorably upon.
060	Sen. Starr Harnish	Asks if there were requests for joint waivers that were denied. Responds no.
065	Sen. Starr	Comments on objections to revision and questions who is objecting and for what reason
074	Danny Santos	Governor's Office. Explains that the Governor had concerns and could not support the bill as it stood. Believes this will give the State Board of Education a safety valve.
087	Sen. Starr	Comments on a constitutional problem. States that he feels strongly about local control and that he will allow this to move forward reluctantly.
105	Rep. Hopson	Comments that local control insists that two parties negotiate together.
110	Sen. Castillo	MOTION: Moves HB 3395 to the floor with the recommendation that the House CONCUR in Senate amendments dated 5/8/01 and that the bill be FURTHER AMENDED by the -B5 amendments and the measure be REPASSED.
