009 Paul Warner	Said that although there are three bills on today's agenda, SB 266 will be delayed until some confidentiality issues can be resolved and SB 299 will be delayed until labor force and ODOT issues can be resolved.	

043 Ed Waters Explained that HB 2271 comes from the Department of Revenue. This bill provides that a taxpayer claiming a credit must claim the maximum amount available, to the extent of tax liability, before calculating a carryover to the next year.

OPENED PUBLIC HEARING ON HB 2271

055 Debra Buchanan Stated that HB 2271 has three objectives. First, it is the Department's belief that very few people would not want to claim the maximum amount of a tax credit in a given tax year. Second, it would conform to federal law, which mandates that a taxpayer claiming a credit use the maximum amount up to the extent of their tax liability. Third, it minimizes confusion for taxpayers and eases administrative issues for the Department of Revenue. Gave an example of how HB 2271 would benefit a taxpayer.
