010 Ed Waters SB 479-A establishes a tax credit for advanced telecommunica-tions facilities in underserved areas, equal to 20 percent of the certified cost of the facilities. Requires taxpayer to obtain certification from the Economic and Community Development Department in order to claim the

tax credit. Allows certifications to be issued between January 1, 2002 and December 31, 2005. Limits the total amount of facility costs certified in a year to \$10 million.
