The House Committee on Judiciary participated in a tour of the Oregon State Hospital's Salem campus. The members and staff visited several units in the Hospital, including an unused residential floor. The tour included learning about therapeutic services provided in service malls, differences between the old campus and the new campus, and the different categories of persons at the Hospital, including those found guilty except for insanity, those who are receiving restorative services prior to trial, those civilly committed, and individuals with geriatric conditions or traumatic brain injuries. The tour included a short discussion with residents and staff about the challenges faced by those in the Hospital. The tour concluded with a visit to the memorial housing the unclaimed remains of persons who died at the Hospital.
