SB 443A WORK SESSION

010	Counsel Horton	SB 443A expands the offense of driving while under the influence of intoxicants to include inhalants. The ñ3 amendments (EXHIBIT A) remove the "vapor-releasing substance" language and include "inhalant" language.
020	Lt. Chuck Hayes	Oregon State Police With the inclusion of (24) on page 2 of the ñ3 amendments, all of the inhalants of abuse are covered.
027	Rep. Prozanski	Expresses his concern with using the word "toxic" on page 2, line 6 of the ñ3 amendments as being too limiting. Is that the same language that you have seen used by other states?
036	Lt. Hayes	The word "toxic" is consistent with other states. We are trying to include in statute the substances that have the ability to impair a personís driving ability, and the language "releasing toxic vapors or fumes" will cover that.
049	Rep. Prozanski	Other states are using "intoxicating" not "toxic".
053	Counsel Horton	It could be the intent of the committee that on page 2, line 6, that the word "toxic" would mean intoxicating as the word toxic is a derivative of the word intoxicating.
057	Chair Mannix	The ñ3 amendments (EXHIBIT A) page 1, line 4, state that a "substance that is capable of causing intoxication".
