058 Richard Yates HB 2190 deals with transferring collection activities for delinquent fuel tax payments to Oregon Dept. of Transportation. Currently, ODOT contracts with Oregon Dept. of Revenue for this. Bill duplicates statutes that apply for weight-mile tax collection.

Discussed HB 2190-1 amendments (**EXHIBIT 1**). Adds new section (13a) that allows ODOT to give refunds, dating back to January 1, 1998.
