<p>This informational trip to the Driver and Motor Vehicles Service Division (DMV) in Salem was not recorded. Guided by Jan Curry, Deputy Director of the DMV, and Bill Seely, Customer Services Director, the committee members toured the building and received information about the DMV's responsibilities, personnel and training (EXHIBIT A). The state facility handles state-wide inquiries from drivers, both by mail and by telephone, while also acting as the center for regulation enforcement, policy making, records and information systems. Areas of particular interest to the committee</p>

members during the tour included: registration procedures, licensing fees, the relationship between the DMV's customer assistance section and the Oregon Women's Correctional Center, insurance requirements and compliance, and technological upgrades.
