Reviewed the A-Eng. measure section by section, referencing the handout of major points on HB 2045 A-Eng. (Exhibit 3)
048	Martin-Mahar	Referenced the revenue impact for the A-Eng. measure and discussed the process in determining the revenue impact; the revenue impact could be an overestimate, but it also does not include any leased equipment. (Exhibit 1)
