Criteria to address opportunities that may be lost if acquisition is delayed. 2. Criteria to protect significant cultural and historic properties. 3. Criteria to satisfy the need for overnight and large group use facilities on the perimeter of urban populations. • Specifies examples of properties. • Directs the State Parks in establishing priorities for acquisition, to consider the criteria and specific examples and to encourage public nomination of significant resources that meet appropriate criteria. • Declares an emergency.
