008	Counsel Tweedt	Discusses SB 50B which modifies the law requiring the court to award attorney fees to the prevailing plaintiff in actions for damages for personal injury or

		property damage where the amount pleaded is \$5,500 or less. SB 50B adds a provision which requires, in a contested case proceeding, an administrative hearing officer to award attorney fees and expenses to a prevailing party if the hearing officer finds that the agency did not have a reasonable basis in fact or law for issuing the order. Indicates that the ñB10 amendments remove the provisions in the bill which relate to attorneyís fees in contested case administrative hearings ( <b>EXHIBIT A</b> ).
019	Chair Bryant	Indicates that there is agreement that an interim work group would address the issues of contested case administrative hearing attorneyís fees.
024	Rep. Williams	Agrees that this would be done during the interim.
045	Rep. Williams	<b>MOTION: Moves to ADOPT SB 50B-B10 amendments dated 7/10/99.</b>
