008	Chair Nelson	Explains that the ñA32 amendments dated 7/14/99 are before the members and will be voted on by the committee.
013	Rep. Hill	MOTION: Moves to SUSPEND the rules for the purpose of reconsidering SB 622A.

014	Rep. King	Asks if the ñA32 amendments are supported by the Governorís Office.
016	Chair Nelson	Responds affirmatively.

022	Rep. Hill	MOTION: Moves SB 622A to the floor with the recommendation that the Senate concur in House amendments dated 06/09/99 and that the bill be further amended with the ñA32 amendments dated 7/14/99, in place of the ñA31 amendments, and the measure be repassed.

Sherry Sheng	<p>Committee Administrator, discusses three changes which distinguish the ñA32 amendments from the previously adopted ñA31 amendments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • -A32, page 22, line 16, matching funds changed from \$500,000 to \$1 million. • -A32, page 32, lines 9 and 10 are inserted for clarification of enforcement action. Lines 16-20 are divided into subsections (a) and (b). • -A32, page 33, previous language "Except where a penalty is otherwise provided by law," has been deleted at beginning of section (6). <p>Explains that the changes are technical in nature and supported by Public Utilities Commission (PUC), Legislative Counsel, Governorís Office and other key interests. Submits (EXHIBIT A).</p>
