008	Chair Derfler	Gives background on SB 654B. Explains why the Senate did not concur with the House on this bill. Says the problem was that the department was being run by a group of people. The conclusion was that one person should be in charge of the agency and use the board as a sounding board. They needed a decision maker. Describes the House amendments to SB 654B. The judges need to act independently. Says the Governor supports the original bill. This amendment allows the Board Chair to control the Administrative Law Judges. Asks for any testimony on this issue.
059	Jennifer Weber	Representing the Oregon Workersí Compensation Attorneys and the Workersí Compensation Section of the Oregon Trial Lawyers Association. Says currently the Workersí Compensation Board disciplines Administrative Law Judges and the association wishes that procedure to remain in force. Explains the concern is that this amendment will adversely affect the judgment of administrative law judges and that there will not be a fair hearing for claimants or defendants. Opposes the amendments.
