<b><u>HB 2549 WORK SESSION</u></b>		
012	Rep. Ron Sunseri	House District 22. States that HB 2549 is essential to school reform. Comments on the importance of reviewing the Certificate of Initial Mastery (CIM).
044	Chair Hartung	Emphasizes that this bill is not an effort to eliminate school reform.
047	Rep. Sunseri	States that Sen. Hartung is correct. Believes that HB 2549 would provide a forum for teachers to express their view on the education reform.
052	Chair Hartung	Agrees with Rep. Sunseri that the education reform needs to be reviewed.
058	Sen. Shannon	Asks Rep. Sunseri what the intention of the committee would be.
064	Rep. Sunseri	Responds that the committee could create interim legislation to provide improvements to the reform.
067	Sen. Shannon	States that legislators need to hear more testimony from teachers.
073	Rep. Sunseri	Refers to a bill that would move the endorsement of the CIM to the community colleges.
085	Sen. Duncan	States that he is opposed to HB 2549.
101	Sen. Shannon	States that this bill would help to keep the legislature informed.
108	Sen. Gordly	Asks Rep. Sunseri if there is a relationship between the Quality Education Model (QEM) task force and the task force outlined in HB 2549.
117	Rep. Sunseri	Responds that there is not a parallel between the two.
124	Sen. Gordly	Asks when the QEM task force will complete its work.
127	Rep. Sunseri	Responds that he is not sure.
129	Sen. Gordly	Asks if the QEM task force will continue through the interim.
132	Rep. Sunseri	Responds that he is not sure.
