		The amended version of HB 2128 passed July 22, 1999 had a series of bills that were in conflict, as it is a major bill and impacts a number of other areas. Counsel has identified all of the conflicts and written amendments, which are currently being copied. That will be before the Committee and there is no substantive change to the bill passed July 22, 1999.

031	Warner	The (-1) amendments were adopted July 22, 1999.
034	Richard Yates	Reviewed the (-2) amendments, which combines what is in the work copy of the (-2) amendments with what was adopted July 22, 1999. (Exhibit 2)
041	Yates	Discussed conceptual amendments that the Committee may want to adopt to be consistent. The measure does not raise any taxes; to make commercial vehicles that are 8,000 pounds or less consistent with passenger cars recommends making all vehicles that are 8,000 pounds or less would pay \$15 annually. The two places in the bill that a change would be needed are on page 43-line 18 and page 53, line 7, (Exhibit 2).
