010 Chair Brian Called meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Opened work session for HB 3748A.

**WORK SESSION -- HB 3748-A**

- 012 Rep. Roberts Explained why he voted against transportation package. Misunderstanding of his intent. He is not against light rail. His opposition to alternative transportation is that it would recapture income taxes from current projects and put into new projects. This circumvented general fund, he felt this was underhanded..  
Directed members' attention to Revenue Impact Statement (EXHIBIT A), Staff Measure Summary (EXHIBIT B), and Fiscal Impact Statement (EXHIBIT C).
- 036 Dick Yates Noted, members already adopted HB 3734 -A25 amendments, a working copy. Noted to, HB 3748 -A26 amendments (EXHIBIT D) add one section to adopted amendments line 21 page 1, section 63, deals with who will pay for cost responsibility study. Subsection 2 puts \$500,000 limit on what can be charged.
- 059 Yates All those amendments are rolled into HB 3748 -A28 amendments (EXHIBIT E). One additional change, also in -A28 amendments, page 39 of A-Engrossed bill, dealing with school districts use fuel tax for school busses, language added, "for those vehicles being used to transport students."
- 063 Yates HB 3748 -27 (EXHIBIT F) are not adopted, are not in -A28 amendments.
- 069 Rep. Edwards Commented on HB 3748 -A27. Money for senior transportation services.

- 103 Rep. Lewis Will vote no, believes Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) must come up with more efficiencies. The \$34 million cut is a good start, there could have been more. That could have been done in this bill. Lawmakers could have demanded more

efficiencies. Suggested hiring freeze on engineering. \$1.7 billion budget.

121 Chair Brian Thanked committee for their work. Bill is improved over HB 3163, requires ODOT performance audit, cost responsibility calculations to address balance between automobiles and trucking. Likes flexible funding in bill.

139 Rep. Edwards Expressed disappointment in regard to flexible funding, bill does not address how things will be funded next two years. Will vote no for now.

151 Rep. Strobeck Urged committee to vote bill out with strongest possible endorsement, send to Senate.

209 Jim Scherzinger Refer to SB 1215 Reconciliation (EXHIBIT H). Written in bold is decision made. Minor construction issue ended up as a compromise between two versions.

Under supervisory authority, added some to tax courts, adopted some standards.

Exclusive remedy provisions, limited to shift provisions only.

240 Scherzinger Directed members' attention to page 426, conflict amendments between historic property. Concerning three-year window in SB 1103, property will continue its historic property exemption without update on second 15-year period. Any other property that goes through reclassification will go to higher value.
