007 Chair Brian Called meeting to order at 8:51 A.M.

**PUBLIC HEARING -- HB 2059**

- 016 Barbara Seymour Explained, HB 2059 and HB 2061 are tax revisers bills. After each legislative session, legislative counsel discovers small errors in bills - words missing or misspelled, etc. In addition, counsel amends out obsolete material. Corrections to tax code are usually contained in big revisers bill. This year the tax material is being treated separately.
- 035 Seymour Directed members' attention to letter to James Scherzinger concerning HB 2059 (EXHIBIT A).
- 055 Seymour Letter, Section 1: Corrects language made obsolete after 1969 legislative session, substitutes "department" for "commission."
- 070 Section 2: Deals with ORS having to do with filing warrants with Secretary of State.
- 081 Sections 3, 4, 5: Clarifies that no appeal will take place until after a deficiency assessment is appealed.
- 104 Chair Brian Clarified that these revisions have no fiscal impact or process impact.
- 118 Seymour Referred to HB 2059, page 2, line 29. Another correction is needed here.
- 133 Rep. Edwards Asked Seymour to describe the process of cleaning up bills after a session.
- 141 Seymour Legislative counsel cleans up mistakes, omissions that do not effect the substance of a bill. This is the first time tax law issues have been separated out.
- 160 Chair Brian Asked if any potential policy implication changes in these two bills.
- 165 Seymour None.
- 190 Rep. Corcoran Expressed concern about HB 2059 -1 Amendments.
- 193 Seymour Referred to Proposed Amendments to House Bill 2059 (EXHIBIT B). This brings language into conformity with SB 164.

299 Seymour HB 2061 deals with deleting obsolete material. Five subjects--refer to letter to James Scherzinger (EXHIBIT D):

Part 1: Homeowner-renter relief program, terminated in 1991.

329 Seymour Part 2: Health insurance pool tax credit.

341 Part 3: Tire fees to clean up old tires. Repealed most sections, missed this one.

357 Part 4: Added an ORS reference that was missed. Initial applications for historic property tax classification.

369 Part 5: Deletes archaic statutes that allow irrigation or drainage district to foreclose upon property if district assessments are delinquent.
