Legislative Counsel.

021 Michael Livingston Lawyer, Department of Justice.

Indicates that the specific concern with the bill is with lines 8, 11, and 13. Explains that with the amendments, social files in delinquency cases of youth offenders would be available to law enforcement officials. Another change proposed by the amendments is clarification that only service providers associated with the case would have access to the file.

095 Travis Explains that the adopted amendments do not require that law enforcement show that there is an investigation occurring or that there might be relevant information in the record. Agrees that the adopted amendments are satisfactory.

103 Rep. Minnis Expresses opposition to the proposed amendments.

105 Chair Stull Expresses concern for the delay in introducing the proposed amendments. Explains that she will work with the Mr. Travis during the interim.

111 Rep. Minnis Suggests an alternative to the proposed amendments. Indicates that an investigator should be part of a multi-disciplinary team.
