002 CHAIR MILNE: Calls meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

HB 2931 PUBLIC HEARING

005 REP. STARR: Introduces HB 2931 and LC-1, LC-2, LC-3 amendments.  
(EXHIBIT A)

035 PHYLISS KIRKWOOD, OREGON SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION: Explains  
partial days and how payment would be figured. Submits and reviews written  
testimony on substitute salary. (EXHIBIT B)

055 LEHMAN: Asked what is the total cost of going from 75% to 80%.

060 KIRKWOOD: Estimates around \$100,000.

090 LEHMAN: Asked if some districts already pay above the base rate.

HB 2931 WORK SESSION

114 MOTION: REP. THOMPSON: Moves the LC-1 amendments to HB 2931.

160 LEHMAN: Comments that this is a unfunded mandate, or a mandate to the  
local school boards that the legislature should not be micro-managing.

195 VOTE: In a roll call vote REP. SNODGRASS, THOMPSON, LUKE, MILNE vote  
AYE. REP. LEHMAN, SHIELDS vote NAY. REP. MEEK is EXCUSED.

CHAIR: The motion CARRIES.

205 MOTION: REP. THOMPSON: Moves HB 2931 as amended to the full committee  
with a DO PASS recommendation.

VOTE: In a roll call vote REP. SHIELDS, SNODGRASS, THOMPSON, LUKE,  
vote AYE. REP. LEHMAN vote NAY. REP. MEEK is excused.

MILNE

CHAIR: The motion CARRIES.

HB 2450 PUBLIC HEARING

230 REP. VANLEEUWEN: Introduces HB 2450 to the committee. Recommends that  
the committee go with the original bill as it was presented.  
268 -Students under the influence of a controlled substance or causing harm  
to themselves.

288 LEHMAN: Asked what is the current law, regarding use of physical force.  
308 -It is his understanding that physical force can be used to maintain  
order in the school or the classroom, and isn't that sufficient.  
355 -Once again, the Legislature is attempting to tell local school boards  
what to do.

390 THOMPSON: Comments that the current law is ambiguous and needs  
clarification.

410 STEPHANIE HOLMES, OREGON SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION: Asked for  
amendment to add other school personnel and school administrators.

457 MOTION: REP. LUKE: Moves the conceptual amendments to HB 2450.

VOTE: Hearing no objections, the motion CARRIES.

MOTION: REP. LUKE: Moves the LC-1 amendments to HB 2450.

VOTE: Hearing no objections, the motion CARRIES.

470 MOTION: REP. LUKE: Moves HB 2450 as amended to the full committee with

a DO PASS recommendation.

HB 3296 PUBLIC HEARING

064 McCOMB: Submits LC-1 amendments to HB 3296. (EXHIBIT C)

HB 3296 WORK SESSION

087 MOTION: REP. LUKE: Moves the LC-1 amendments to HB 3296.

VOTE: Hearing no objections, the motion CARRIES.

095 MOTION: REP. LUKE: Moves HB 3296 as amended to the full committee with

a DO PASS recommendation.

VOTE: In a roll call vote all members present vote AYE. REP. MEEK ,  
SHIELDS are EXCUSED.

HB 3317 WORK SESSION

117 SNODGRASS: Explains the LC-3 amendments that clarify that this is for  
human sexuality curriculum only, and curriculum specific. (EXHIBIT D)

157 THOMPSON: Concern that parents who are not involved in their children's  
education, or do not pay attention, will not send back the permission slip.

Then students will not get the information they need.

212 SNODGRASS: There is no clause that this has to be put into place right  
away. Is not wanting to pass legislation that will cause a financial  
burden on the schools.

230 LUKE: The bills go into effect 90 days after the Governor signs and the  
session ends.
