168 TIERNAN: Was there any arguments presented at the hearing as to why this shouldn't happen?

170 PROZANSKI: Explains the discussion in crime subcommittee about executive directors position.

183 TIERNAN: Were the questions answered?

184 PROZANSKI: No.

185 ROBINSON: Explains Rep. Courtney's concerns about waiting to get official opinion from the Justice council. Explains representation for board members and length for stay on board.

202 CHAIR PARKS: Asks about opportunity of chairperson to stay on committee.

210 DAVID FACTOR, EXEC. DIRECTOR OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL: Explains board status and position, cites concern on expertise of staff over that of chairperson status.

231 PROZANSKI: The executive director is the person who is most involved and would give information to chairperson, to be shared with the Justice council.?

237 FACTOR: That is correct, explains.

249 TIERNAN: Do you recommend that this is a bill that will better the process?

252 FACTOR: I don't see any harm in substitution of this member, explains.

263 TIERNAN: The agency chair does turnover annually?

264 FACTOR: Yes, but they can be re-appointed.
