006 MOTION: REP. BROWN: Moves to reconsider the vote by which HB 2161  
was moved from subcommittee.

007 CHAIR PARKS: The motion CARRIES.

009 MOTION: REP. BROWN: Moves HB 2161 to the Ways and Means  
committee with a do pass recommendation or a letter from the Chair.

012 REP. TIERNAN: I'd like to know what the bill is about, what it does.
