238 SPENCER LENNARD, JOSEPHINE COUNTY: Reads from prepared testimony, regarding bear poaching, depletion of bear population. Opposes HB 2584.

315 - Continues reading from testimony. (Exhibit I) Cruel, unethical and risky management techniques.

345 REP. UHERBELAU: Comments about poaching.

353 LENNARD: Take away the "easy, legal"ability to poach. Calls for absolute conservation; has no problem with hunting ethics.
