011 MOTION: REP. LUKE: Moves HB 2016 as amended to the full committee with

a DO PASS recommendation .

047 $$\rm MOTION:\ REP.$ UHERBELAU: Moves HB 3332 to the full committee with a DO PASS recommendation.

053 REP. LUKE: If something happens to the non-profit that takes over the property, then the tax payers end up being responsible. The liability issues bother him, especially if the non-profits default and the city or county have to take the property back.

060 REP. FISHER: Objects land being taken back due to unpaid taxes, and

taxable property being taken off the tax rolls.

073 $\,$ REP. UHERBELAU: Has thought about REP. LUKE'S objection as well. It would be on the local tax roll if it were not given to the non-profit.

083 $\,$ REP. NAITO: This is just one tool you would give to the local government.

089 DAN SALTZMAN, MULTNOMAH COUNTY COMMISSIONER: Property being considered for transfer to a non-profit land trust would have deed restrictions forbidding sale or transfer of property, it would revert back to the County.

101 REP. LUKE: If you give this to a non-profit and they do a nice park, and it fails, the expense of the facility will fall to the county to care and maintain.

111 SALTZMAN: That is true with any abandoned property. It allows the county commission to decide what is the best use of property within their county.

120 $\,$ REP. LUKE: If the non-profit contaminates the ground soil, who cleans it up.

125 SALTZMAN: The previous property owner is ultimately responsible. Deed restrictions would probably limit the non-profits possibility to contaminate.

128 REP. LUKE: Asks about the definition of a political subdivision.

134 SALTZMAN: Language supplied by legislative counsel.

137 REP. FISHER: Doesn't see any limitation as to what size of property. Is

there any limitation.

147 SALTZMAN: No size limits. Foreclosed properties come in all sizes.

154 REP. UHERBELAU: Withdraws the previous motion.

160 $$\rm MOTION:\ REP.$ UHERBELAU: Moves HB 3332 to the full committee without recommendation.
