003      OPENS WORK SESSION ON HB 2164.

004      HOLLY ROBINSON, Legal Counsel: Summarizes HB 2164 and the amendments adopted in the House and the Senate.  
-Submits into committee record testimony from the Oregon State Police. (Exhibit A).

024      CHAIR PARKS: Proposes the -3 Amendments to solve the discrepancies between the Senate and House amendments. (Exhibit B.)  
-Explains why the defense member and public at large were put back in and the judge was left out.

028      ROBINSON: In response to Sen. Baker: Yes, the "defense bar" is specific enough.

030      MOTION: SEN. HAMBY: Moves the ADOPTION of the HB 2164 -B3 dated 5/23/95.

037      VOTE: In a roll call vote, REP. BAKER, SEN. HAMBY, REP. LEWIS, REP. PROZANSKI and CHAIR PARKS vote AYE. SEN. SORENSON is EXCUSED.

045      REP. LEWIS: Apologizes for her lateness and requests information on the -B3 amendments.

047      CHAIR PARKS: Explains for Rep. Lewis the -3 Amendments to the bill. Ask Rep. Lewis how she votes?

057      REP. LEWIS: Votes AYE. (Please note Rep. Lewis is included in the vote within line 037.)

058      CHAIR PARKS: The MOTION CARRIES.
