- OO5 CHAIR SNODGRASS: Calls meeting to order at 1:42 p.m.
- 010 -Explains the HB 2991-B56 amendments (EXHIBIT A)
 - -The hand engrossed version of the bill (EXHIBIT B)
 - -The comparison done by staff (EXHIBIT C)
- O44 -Section 4 (7) changed to "in a constitutional republic"
- O83 -Section 6, deletes second language and the arts, adds physical education and health.
- 115 -Section 7, refers to extended school models and Department of Education

shall study the feasibility and report the findings of the study to the sixty-ninth Legislative Assembly.

- 150 -Section 8, definition of "criterion-referenced assessment" and "content-based assessment"
- 173 -Section 10, educational standards establishment and implementation
- 214 -Section 13, Oregon Report Card, add sub-section (e) "share evaluations of unsuccessful instructional and organizational strategies.
- 258 -Section 15, changed from welfare of the child and the family, to "welfare of the child in the family....
- Section 17, established funding for pre-kindergarten programs by 1999 at
- 50% funding and by 2004 full funding.
- 325 CHAIR SNODGRASS: Recesses the meeting at 2:00 p.m. -Re-convenes the meeting at 2:23 p.m.

- -Continues reviewing the hand engrossed version of the bill (EXHIBIT B)

 -Section 21, child development specialist.
- 374 SEN. BAKER: Dealing with whole spectrum, social differences, emotional differences, economic differences and would like to keep it as a broad statement.
- 394 SEN. GOLD: Certificate of accomplishment, addresses the early intervention kids.
- REP. SNODGRASS: Section 23; additional language will be inserted here dealing with adopting standards to ensure measuring tools.
- 435 -In order for the CIM to continue, need to adopt new standards.
- 460 -Additional time to establish new standards for CIM.

TAPE 3, SIDE A

- 015 SEN. BAKER: Any comments from State Board that they need additional time?
- 018 REP. SNODGRASS: Will ask them if they need the additional time.
 -Schools are then given another year to implement CIM standards.
- 028 REP. ROSS: Then those standards would not be adopted before the next legislative session.
- 032 REP. SNODGRASS: They could report to an interim committee until the next session.
- -Section 22, line 28 (2) certificate of individual mastery or certificate of individual accomplishment.
- 062 REP. MEEK: Term "certificate of individual accomplishment"
- 072 SEN. BAKER: Sees this as a student that has deficiency that they cannot overcome but have achievable goals
- 080 REP. MEEK: Likes giving both students a CIM; why distinguish the difference?
 - -IEP students
- 109 SEN. GOLD: At the appropriate time, thinks we should defer this to the Department.
- 120 REP. SNODGRASS: Section 23, Lines 35-40. Demonstration the skills.
 -Lines 41-42; individuals in group settings.
- -Subsection (4); added timeline of January 1998 for district plans to be submitted.
- -Section 25, 26 and 27 deleted feasibility study and replaced with new language regarding
 - diplomas, foreign language and CIM, CAM and career indorsements.
- -Section 25 (5); certificate for those who fall under the IEP students and those that exceed standards.
- 218 REP. ROSS: Thinks that language about additional certificates needs to be re-worded to better reflect intent; hard to understand.
- REP. MEEK: Clarification on additional certificates and placing the decision to issue additional certificates to the local school board.
