088 CHAIR KINTIGH: Recommends deletion of 13.

089 SEN. BRADBURY: Regarding item 17; when a measure is tabled and put back on agenda, we should be reminded that it was tabled.

090 CHAIR KINTIGH: Questions if this process would be for the administrator
or staff to notify members that bill was previously tabled.
098 SEN. BRADBURY: Either would be fine.
098 SEN. DWYER: Agreed that would be adequate
101 SEN. JOHNSON: Paragraph/Item 17 could be clarified to address the
concern. Revise it to reflect that in addition to being placed on agenda, the majority of the
committee would have to approve it. Delete 13 like the Water Committee.
107 SEN. BRADBURY: Asked that it be tabled and to be reminded that this
issue was tabled later.
110 SEN. DWYER: Mason and Senate rules state this request. Wishes 13 be
deleted.
124 SEN. JOHNSON: Suggests to delete 13.
133 SEN. HARTUNG: Would the rules require two members to file a minority
report?
140 CHAIR KINTIGH: It will take two or more to file.

145 SEN. DWYER: Moves that the rules be adopted.

152 CHAIR KINTIGH: Asks for roll call vote.
Motion carried unanimously. All members are present.

169 CHAIR KINTIGH: Outlines parameters of operations of the committee for
1995.

committee will make every effort to start and end the meetings on time if
at all possible.
Requests that when testimony is being given, questions be held until the
end. Asks that
members refrain from making speeches and actually ask questions. To
potential witnesses, if
there is a member who sponsors the bill wishes to lead off, it will be
granted; then citizens will
follow especially if they have come from a long distance, and those in the
building all the time
can come back another day. There will be time limits and groups will be
encouraged to
combine their testimony to expedite the process. Invites everyone to visit
with him on any
matters of concern.
