Trow, explains rationale for measure to continue "the practices that existed for litigant Liberty Mutual who has agreed that with passage of this in the form described, they will withdraw their lawsuit...what all this is about is to get those suits behind us" 130 Chair Phillips -states that another interpretation may be that "if you sue the state, you can then use that as a negotiation chip to lower your tax burden" -discussion about whether any further litigation may be expected and legal validity of agreements not to sue 177 John Mangen -Oregon Insurers (represents Standard Insurance Company and eight other domestic insurers who are intervenors and parties in litigation against the State of Oregon, and defense of the State of Oregon in the case brought by Liberty Mutual of Boston and Liberty NW of Portland/Pacific Health and Life) 196 -suggests correction to the Proposed (-20) Amendments to HB 2855B clarifying for the record that "our system (in Oregon) has never been ruled unconstitutional" -gives opinion about relevance of this legislation and expresses 196 concerns about using the court system to gain legislative solutions -states work by coalition to draft measure and amendments which "are 204 good amendments and will help bring this issue to conclusion with the proper agreements from the foreign companies 225 -discussion of tradeoffs, Attorney General opinion, involvement in "the rush to settlement", uncertainty about liability of the State of Oregon, option of legislature dealing with this issue in a special session in January, and desire by the legislature and administration to move forward in order to reduce the possibility of litigation Mangen -comments on Section 20 of HB 2855B regarding local tax exemption 278 that would preserve the status quo and cautions about subjecting new law to future litigation 330 -"we really believe this bill should not be passed unless there are signed and written agreements that current and future litigation will be released" Chair Phillips -adjourns public hearing and committee at 4:41 pm 350
