003 CHAIR MILLER: Calls the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

005 Opens Public Hearing on SB 1097.

010 JOE GILLIAM, Testifies in support of SB 1097.

035 SEN. SPRINGER: Notes that Sections 2 and 3 of the bill do not clarify how wide the geographic scope would be. Asks if the measure would require impact statements on property outside the state of Oregon.

040 GILLIAM: Believes statutory reference in Section 1 only pertains to the state of Oregon.

045 SEN. SPRINGER: Wants clarification on the measure.

055 SEN. GOLD: Requests testimony from the Dept. of Administrative Services and fiscal impact analysis.

075 CHAIR MILLER: Closes Public Hearing on SB 1097.

079 Introduces interim rules of the Senate.

080 KRISTINA McNITT, COMMITTEE ADMINISTRATOR: Reviews proposed interim Senate Rules. Highlights changes.

119 SEN. SPRINGER: Asks about the reconsideration provisions. Asks if this

is a substantive change from a vote of 16, to a majority of those present and voting.

125 McNITT: That was done in the Senate Rules.

138 SEN. SPRINGER: Believes 16 votes are required to reconsider.

176 CHAIR: Recesses the committee at 10:15 a.m.

176 Reconvenes committee at 3:20 p.m.

180 Reopens discussion of interim rules

182 CHAIR: Asks if Sen. Springer would support removal of the language in "bold" and returning to the previous language, which would require 16 votes to reconsider a motion.

193 MOTION: SEN. SPRINGER: MOVES TO AMEND PROPOSED INTERIM RULES TO READ A MAJORITY (16 VOTES) IS REQUIRED TO ADOPT A MOTION TO RECONSIDER THE VOTE.

VOTE: WITHOUT OBJECTION, CHAIR MILLER DECLARES AMENDMENT ADOPTED. SENATORS ADAMS AND PHILLIPS ARE EXCUSED.

201 MOTION: SEN. SPRINGER: MOVES THE INTERIM RULES AS AMENDED BE ADOPTED.

205 SEN. GOLD: Clarifies that the other proposed changes are still included.

215 VOTE: WITHOUT OBJECTION, CHAIR MILLER DECLARES RULES, AS AMENDED, ARE ADOPTED.

215 CHAIR MILLER: Will carry rules to the floor.
